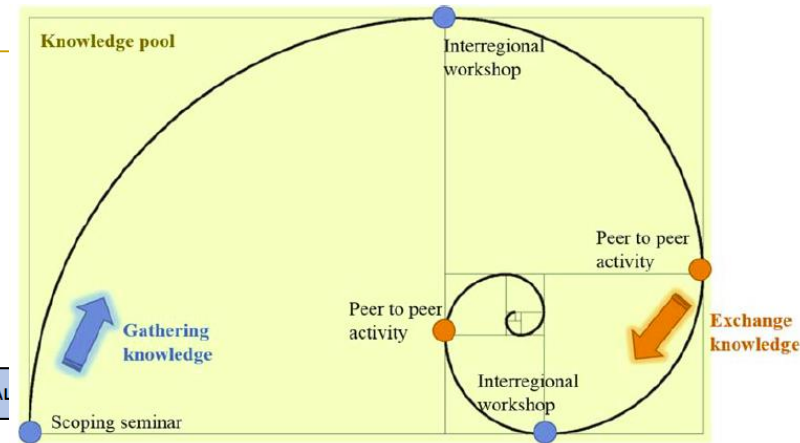

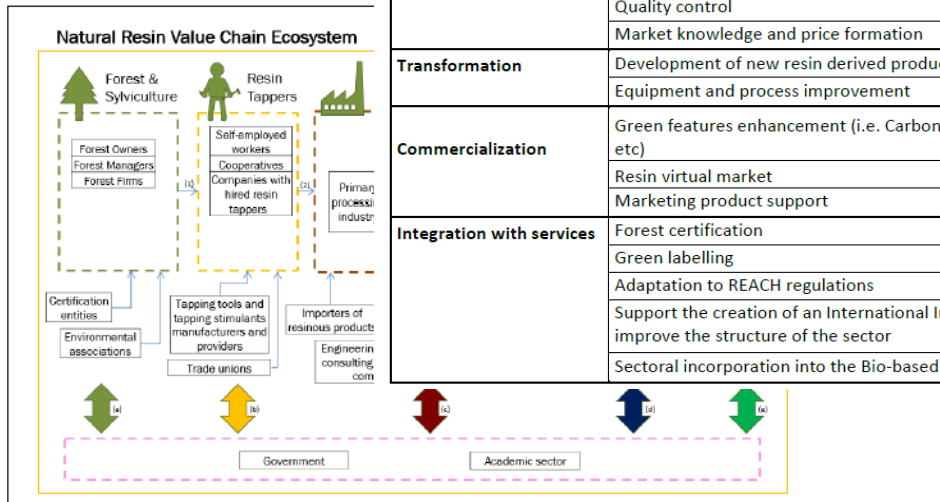

<b>Commercialization</b>	Green features enhancement (i.e. Carbon footprint assessment, stamp of origin, etc)

<b>Integration with services</b>	Forest certification
	Green labelling
	Adaptation to REACH regulations
